South Devon Chilli Farm Adds a Fourth Chilli Chocolate to its Range.

The chocolatiers at the South Devon Chilli Farm have done it again! Following the success of their Original Chilli Chocolate, Orange Chilli Chocolate and Peppermint Chilli Chocolate, South Devon Chilli Farm are releasing a fourth flavour in time for Christmas - 'Fruit&Spice'. This new flavour has their sought-after chilli-chocolate experience, with added sultanas and ground spice - cinnamon, nutmeg and cloves.

The South Devon Chilli Farm has been growing a wide range of chillies for the past six years, and the majority of the chillies they grow are used to make their growing range of chilli products. **"Our range of Chilli Chocolates has a large fan base, and we're often asked: What's next?,"** says Steve Waters, a director of the South Devon Chilli Farm.

After extensive trials with many different chilli varieties, South Devon Chilli Farm announced their first Chilli Chocolate product in 2003. Since then, the demand has grown remarkably: **"With the range of chilli flavours we have to play with, it took us a little while to find the right mix, but the research seems to be paying-off now,"** says Steve.

The South Devon Chilli Farm was formed in 2001 by two friends with a common interest in growing and consuming chillies - Steve Waters (48) and Jason Nickels (41). Since then, the company has expanded quickly from attending local market stalls, to nationwide distribution of its range of chilli preserves and chilli confectionery. All of their products are made on the farm in a purpose-built facility. Since starting up, South Devon Chilli Farm has been presented with many regional and national food-industry awards.
