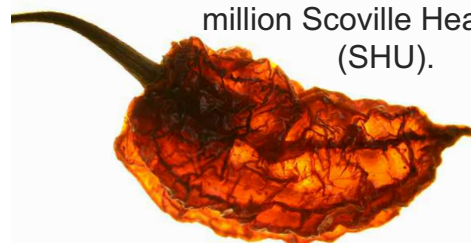
## Our New Chilli Growing Kits

## 2008 Dried Chillies in stock

We have invested in a larger drying shed this year and the first stock is now available. As well as our own range of dried chillies, we have also imported the current world record-holding chilli from Assam, India - the Bhut Jolokia, also known as the Naga Jolokia - these chillies have a great flavour, but they are VERY, VERY hot (see our new Chilli Handling kit below).

A dried Bhut Jolokia chilli - measured at over one million Scoville Heat Units (SHU).

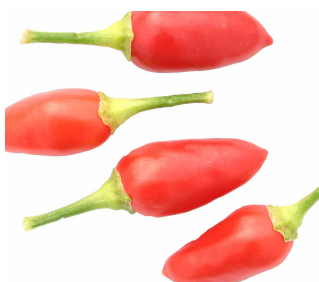


## 'Coffee Bean' Chilli Chocolate
